<u>Library Book</u> Check-out Procedures



Books will be available for check out on Monday, May 18 in the Extended Care room in the main building. Please sign up for your time slot https://www.signupgenius.com/go/30e0a4ca8ae28a 2ff2-hfslibrary

One family group will be permitted into the Extended Care room at a time. Students may choose up to 5 books. There are some books for parents as well.

- 1. Please drop off any books that you are returning in the crates in the hallway.
- 2. When you enter the Extended Care room, please use the hand sanitizer before touching any books.
- 3. Books are laying flat on the tables so you can see the titles and cover. If you pick up a book, please take that book.
- 4. Use the clean pencils and index cards to write your name and the names of the books you have chosen.
- 5. Place the used pencils into the designated container.
