COVID Prevention Update

Many COVID symptoms mimic the common cold and flu. If your child has these symptoms in the morning before school, its best to keep them home. If the symptoms disappear the next day you should be good to come to school, however, if not, please follow the COVID flowchart.

The COVID Flowchart tells us that a student may return to school after 10 days the symptom started or when there is a negative test and 24 hours fever free (without medication).

Thank you everyone for doing your very best to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and all infectious diseases!

The Thurston County COVID Student Pathway for our official reporting pathway. You can find the King County Flow Chart that is a bit more clear to understand as well - https://tinyurl.com/COVIDSymptomsFlowchart This details the symptoms of COVID and when to keep your child home. Please read the entire page - the last column explains that if your child has one or more new symptoms (unrelated to a preexisting condition such as seasonal allergies) and if your child does not have a COVID test, then he or she can return 10 days after symptoms started AND

at least 24 hours have passed since fever resolved (without medication) AND symptoms have improved. When in doubt, stay home and call your health professional, then call us to keep us in the loop. Thank you!

Mother/Son Scavenger Hunt


