This past Tuesday, we honored Mary by reciting a decade of the 1st Joyful mystery at our school-wide zoom prayer service. Food for thought ...”Did you know that some people consider each Hail Mary as a rose being given to Mary?” A student shared that with us. A beautiful thought!!

Next Tuesday, we will honor Mary with a Coronation prayer service. It is tradition to have the 8th grade girls crown Mother Mary while the First Communion students lead the 8th graders in a procession and recite the Litany to Mother Mary.
